I had a brief look at the list, but I'm afraid I've never heard of many of the substances! I think we would need to be guided by SMARTI as to whether there are actually any medicines containing those substances. If there aren't, we then have to decide whether to list them in the first schedule anyway, or leave them to be added if/when a medicine product comes along. I'm not sure there is any danger in leaving them out until there a medicine product, because they are still controlled drugs and the MODA controls apply. If we are trying to provide clarity in relation to those that are actually used as medicines, then perhaps we should only list those ones. Happy to be convinced otherwise, though!

Sorry I can't be of more assistance at this stage but could help you with it next week.

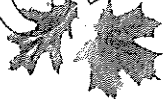
